

BY ROAD:

- Leave M6 Motorway at junction 16. Follow signs to Crewe / Nantwich.
- At the first roundabout straight on signed Nantwich /Chester.
- Carry straight on through 3 more roundabouts. After the third you will come to some traffic lights turn left A525
- > Straight through the next set off lights.
- Turn right at the next set signed Whitchurch A525.
- Take the second turning on your left signed Whitchurch. You go past a lake on you right hand side.
- About another 3miles you will enter the small village of Aston. TURN RIGHT to Wrenbury. Follow signs. 2 Miles you will come to the end of the road facing you is a school.
- Turn left keep going 3/4 mile you will come to a lift bridge go over the bridge the Marina is on the right

BY AIRPORT OR RAIL: From the London Airports: Make your way either by the London Underground airport shuttle bus or taxi to Euston Main Line rail terminal in central London. Board the Inter-City Express to Crewe (trains depart frequently for the North West, journey time is approximately 2 hours), then travel by taxi to Wrenbury.

From Manchester International Airport: Take the airport bus to Manchester Piccadilly station which leaves every half an hour.

At the station board a train for Crewe. At Crewe take a taxi from outside the station to Wrenbury marina (see address below). Please contact taxi company for estimate. Wrenbury Marina

LLANGOLLEN & RETURN • 7 Nights • Cruising Time Per day: 5.5 Hrs • Locks: 24

- If you would like to travel to Llangollen, but were looking to complete more locks, then start from Wrenbury Marina rather than Whitchurch or Blackwater Meadow.
- The last locks before Llangollen are at New Marton, half way between Ellesmere and Chirk.
- From there on the canal clings to the hillside contours. An enchanting blend of aqueducts and tunnels will take you lock free through to Llangollen.

ELLESMERE PORT & RETURN • 7 Nights • Cruising Time Per day: 6.5 Hrs • Locks: 48

- From Wrenbury you will travel up the Llangollen Canal to join the Shropshire Union Canal and travel up to the industrial town of Ellesmere Port.
- Why not visit the National Waterways Museum which brings together a unique fleet of historic boats and archives to tell the story of Britains canals and waterways?

MARKET DRAYTON • 7 Nights • Cruising Time Per day: 5 Hrs • Locks: 82

- When you join the Shropshire Union Canal at Hurleston Junction head down the canal to Market Drayton.
- Did you know Market Drayton has been the home of gingerbread for the last 200 years (find out more at www.shropshiretourism.co.uk/market-drayton)?

THE CHESHIRE RING • 11-14 Nights • Cruising Time Per day: 6 Hrs • Locks: 137

- It is recommended to travel this ring clockwise, so heading up to Manchester.
- The ring takes in the whole of the Macclesfield Canal, parts of the Trent & Mersey, Bridgewater, Rochdale, Ashton and Peak Forest Canals, providing a range of scenery.
- Enjoy glorious scenery as the Macclesfield Canal skirts the edge of the Pennines.
- If time allows why not take a detour from Marple along the Peak Forest Canal and enjoy stunning views.
- You will cruise through the heart of Manchester and moor at Castlefield to explore the city and places such as the Old Trafford , home of 'Man U'(www.manutd.co.uk), the Arndale shopping centre or the Museum of Science and Industry (www.mosi.org.uk).
- This route has a variety of canal features including broad and narrow locks, aqueducts and tunnels, and the distinctive stone architecture of the Peak District.

FOUR COUNTIES RING • 14 Nights • Cruising Time Per day: 6 Hrs • Locks: 132

- Takes you along the wonderfully rural Staffordshire & Worcestershire Canal to Great Haywood Junction.
- · Passing under a distinctive roving bridge, you join the Trent & Mersey Canal heading north towards the Potteries and Peak District.
- Rolling Staffordshire countryside leads you to Stoke-on-Trent, the Wedgwood Visitor Centre and the impressive 2926-yard long Harecastle Tunnel.
- The scenery on the climb up 'Heartbreak Hill' to the summit at Kidsgrove is fantastic.
- Beyond Harecastle the 13 miles to the salt town of Middlewich sees the canal descend 31 locks to the Cheshire Plains.
- The short Middlewich arm links the Trent and Mersey Canal to the Shropshire Union Canal again through more glorious countryside.
- · Don't miss the Bottle Kilns at Etruria.

Whitchurch & return • 3 NIGHTS • CRUISING TIME PER DAY 4hrs • TOTAL LOCKS 20

Travel between our Wrenbury and Whitchurch Marinas and explore Whitchurch before you return (www.shropshiretourism.co.uk/whitchurch). Ellesmere & return • 3 NIGHTS • CRUISING TIME PER DAY 8½hrs • TOTAL LOCKS 20

The run into Ellesmere is through an area of outstanding beauty, with a series of Ice-Age lakes known as 'meres' very close to the canal. Chirk & return • 4 NIGHTS • CRUISING TIME PER DAY 6hrs • TOTAL LOCKS 24

Towards the Welsh border at Chirk the country's fine hills come into view and the scenery becomes altogether more dramatic.
